

VEDAMO checklist for web-content accessibility

Text

Accessibility

- Readable
- True text
- Sans-serif fonts
- Appropriate font styles and size

Design

- Short text materials presented in key points, bullets, tables, and diagrams
- Information relevant to the learners' level and individual needs
- Good readability

Images

Accessibility

- High resolution
- Limited use of animated images
- Appropriate size of the images and graphic objects so that they are visible to the participants
- Participants are informed that they can zoom in and out of the whiteboard if needed
- Add captions when you have more than one image on a certain whiteboard page

Design

- The images, graphic objects, and animated images are relevant to the content
- They enrich the content and respond to the objectives of the lesson

Audio/Video

Accessibility

- Users are informed that they can control their own volume level
- Users are informed that they can resize the media player according to their own preferences

Design

- Clear audio
- No background noise
- Good quality of the video
- Short video length (1.5-2 minutes)

Multimedia

Accessibility

- Good balance in the amount and types of the different media used

Design

- Plain design (adequate selection of colors and background contrast)
- Logical sequence of content
